Governing document

The charity is controlled by its governing document, a deed of trust, and constitutes an unincorporated charity.

Recruitment and appointment of new trustees

The Charity shall elect the officers and other trustees, save that the trustees shall have the power to appoint a trustee ('the new trustee') in circumstances where a trustee has resigned or is otherwise incapable of performing adequately their duties as trustees. The appointment of the new trustee shall be subject to the notification of the members of the Charity in the general meeting next following the appointment of the new trustee.

Risk management

The trustees have a duty to identify and review the risks to which the charity is exposed and to ensure appropriate controls are in place to provide reasonable assurance against fraud and error.

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

The Charity's objects are to relieve and assist the aged and needy residents of the Albert Edward Prince of Wales Court ('the Court') and for that purpose to provide a link between Albert Edward Prince of Wales Court and masonic organisations of all kinds.

The Charity may assist such persons in any of the following ways:-

4) By the provision of social and recreational amenities of all kinds for the residents as shall promote the general welfare and happiness of the Court.

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES
